Enjoy the magical Christmas atmosphere of the romantic Old Town
and taste the traditional „Glühwein“ and „Thüringer Bratwurst“



What better than to tour Hannover's festively illuminated Old Town and city centre and get into the seasonal mood in the run up to Christmas.

This Christmas market covers 3 parts:

Traditional Christmas Market

All round the Market Church craftsmen exhibit their products and workmanship at a range of Christmas stalls, which also serve delicious seasonal refreshments.

Here **(A)** you can use the pink (chip) voucher at the „Vorloh's Glühwein“. It is located on the left site of the market church entry. The voucher is valid for 1 Glühwein or 1 hot chocolate. You have to pay 2 EUR deposit for the cup which will be paid back when returning the cup.



Finnish Christmas village (Ballhofplatz)

At Ballhofplatz square grilled salmon roasting on an open fire, the delicious aroma of Glögi is wafting around the Lapland tent, and Nordic craftsmen are selling their Scandinavian hand-crafted products.

Historic Christmas village (Hohes Ufer)

At the banks of river Leine flaming fire baskets and authentic bygone handicrafts take you back in time to the Christmas of yesteryear.

Directly at the corner „Am Hohen Ufer“ / „Pferdestraße“ you will find a big rotatable grill „Thüringer Bratwurst“ **(B)**. Here you can show the second voucher and taste the famous sausage.
